Itinerary

Friday 4 September – arrive at Grange Farm, check in from midday. Evening fish & chip run to The Three Bishops Pub in Brighstone

Saturday 5 September – IOW Branch Drive Out from IOW Steam Railway, Havenstreet from 1pm, evening BBQ with entertainment from 6pm, please bring own food. The bar will be open for drinks

Sunday 6 September – IOW Branch Rally at IOW Steam Railway, please arrive on site by 9.30am. Free entry which includes access to the railway facilities (train journeys are payable). The Club also hold a post Rally meal in the evening at Appley Manor in Ryde which everyone is welcome to attend

Monday 7 September – visit to Carisbrooke Castle followed by evening Bingo Session at The Three Bishops pub in Brighstone

Tuesday 8 September - car free day, travelling by bus to The Needles Landmark Attraction

Wednesday 9 September – day trip to Ryde, visit to IW Bus Museum, afternoon ten pin bowling at Ryde Superbowl, followed by dinner at The Alamo

Thursday 10 September – visit Osborne House, the home of Queen Victoria, followed by farewell evening meal at The Three Bishops pub

Friday 11 September – free day to explore the island and visit one of the many attractions!

Saturday 12 September - check out from Grange Farm by 12 noon

There is also the option to take part in the Isle of Wight Classic Motor Show on 12-13th September at Newport Harbour on Saturday and Ryde seafront on Sunday – a huge classic car event attended by many cars from the mainland as well as local islanders.
