
Let's get cracking and have some real fun at **Easter**.

### **Get your Easter bonnets** out folks!

Yes if you really want to join in all the fun of the season, you need to come up with a real cracker of a hat.

And Meg and I have come up with some great instructions to let you make them yourselves, instead of taking the easy way out and buying one.

Simply start with a base hat and decorate it with Easter-themed items like flowers, eggs, chicks, rabbits, or grass, using glue or hot glue for attachment.

#### Here's a more detailed guide:



Base Hat: You can use a straw hat, a paper plate, or even a cardboard circle.

#### **Decorations**

Easter Eggs: Plastic eggs, foam eggs, or even chocolate eggs.

Flowers: Artificial flowers, pipe cleaners, or felt flowers.

Animals: Chicks, bunnies, or other Easter-themed animals.

Grass: Green craft foam, shredded tissue paper, or raffia.

Other Embellishments: Feathers, ribbons, or beads.

Adhesives: Craft glue, glue gun, or glue dots.



#### Prepare the Base

Cover the hat: You can cover a straw hat with tissue paper or paint it in bright colors as a base for your decorations.

Create a grass base: Cut green craft foam into strips and create grass-like edges around the hat.

Make a nest: Use raffia or twigs to create a nest shape on top of the hat.



Attach the grass: Glue the grass strips around the base of the hat.

Add the nest: Glue the raffia or twigs to the hat to create a nest.

Arrange decorations: Glue or hot glue the Easter eggs, flowers, animals, and other embellishments onto the hat.

**Get creative:** You can create a chick bonnet, a bunny bonnet, a spring bonnet, or a magical farm bonnet



#### **Finishing Touches**

Add ribbons or bows: Tie ribbons or bows around the brim of the hat.

Attach embellishments: Glue on feathers, beads, or other embellishments for a final touch.

Let it dry: Allow the glue to dry completely before wearing your Easter
