Because the postman has been again and this time, he has brought us some fabulous news from **Leona Baos** of Cardiff.

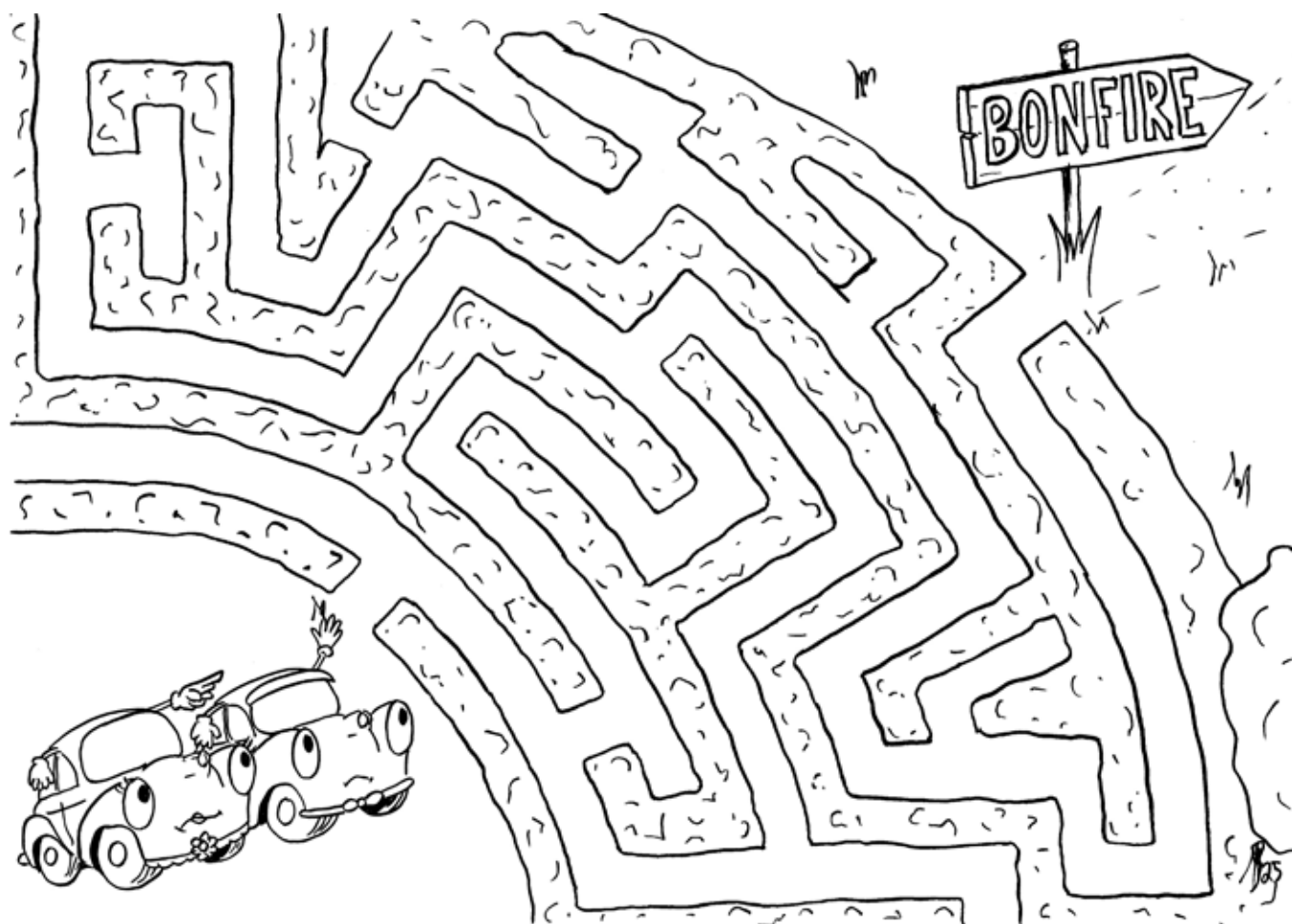
